MAP SHOWING AFFECTED AREAS

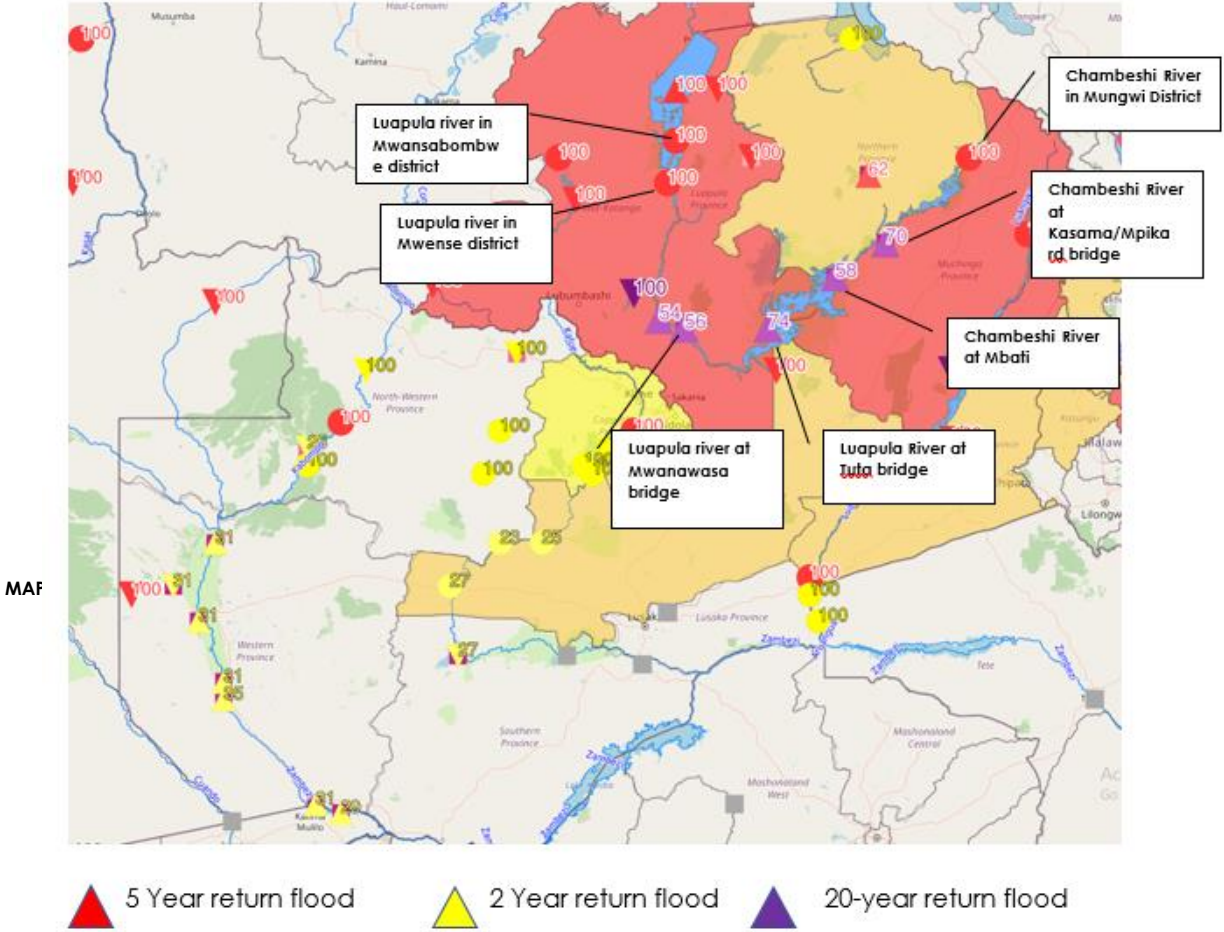


Figure 1 GloFAS Triggers for Floods
